In this day-long symposium, Dr. Power will explore a new framework for supporting people who live with Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia. Participants will:

- Review the problems with overuse of psychotropic medications, the limitations of a narrow biomedical model for dementia and the shift to an “experiential” model.
- Understand why our attempts at person-centered care and non-pharmacological interventions often fall short.
- Identify why the **seven domains of well-being** are challenged in people living with dementia, and how they can be restored.
- Explore the precepts of transforming the care environment and how this “culture change” process is integral to new approaches to care, wherever people may live.

This program will be highly interactive and specific discussion topics will be tailored to the needs of the audience.

About Al Power:

G. Allen Power is an internist, geriatrician, and clinical associate professor of medicine at the University of Rochester. He is also a Certified Eden Alternative® Educator, a member of the Eden Alternative board of directors and an international educator on transformational models of care for older adults, particularly those living with changing cognitive abilities.

Dr. Power is the author of *Dementia beyond Drugs: Changing the Culture of Care* and his new book, *Dementia Beyond Disease: Enhancing Well-Being* is scheduled for release by Health Professions Press in summer 2014.
